**Coedybryn:** Sympathy was extended to Cllr. Sian Williams & family who have recently lost a cousin out in Australia.

**Rhydlewis:** An expert has been out to look at the tree at Twrgwyn. He is happy that the tree is safe and has signed a statement to confirm this.

**Croeslan :** Camddwr have been out to cut the grass and have done a good job. The phone kiosk is being disconnected. Long grass is growing on the pavement between Croeslan and Ffostrasol. It's looking very untidy and needs to be processed through CLIC.

A tenant at either flat 1 or 3 Croeslan Villa has put up a bamboo fence round her garden and this is proving to be a problem on the junction because drivers can't see whether vehicles are coming. Cllr. Mark Davies knows the tenants and is hoping to have a word with them.
